Rett Syndrome Facts

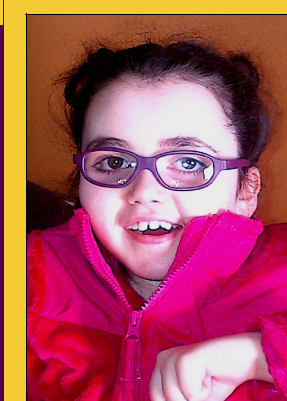

- a neurological disorder
- often misdiagnosed as autism, cerebral palsy or non-specified developmental delay
- caused by a defective regulatory MECP2 gene, found on the X chromosome
- seen almost exclusively in females.
- known to occur from 1:10,000 to 1:23,000 female births
- first described by Dr. Andreas Rett in 1964
- development appears normal until 6-18 months of age
- followed by loss of acquired speech and hand skills, slowing of head growth and development of stereotyped repetitive hand movements, loss or difficulty with mobility
- hand movements include hand-washing, hand wringing, hand tapping, hand clapping, hand mouthing
- additional problems may include seizures, breathing irregularities (hyperventilation and apnea), teeth grinding and curvature of the spine (scoliosis)
